

FELINE INFECTIOUS PERITONITIS (WET FORM) FELINE OMEGA INTERFERON PROTOCOL**

PRIMARY TREATMENT

Drainage of the effusion liquid
One injection (in situ) of dexamethasone 1mg/kg

INDUCTION STAGE (the day after)

Feline Omega Interferon (FOI)
1 MU/Kg SC, e.o.d until remission
(4 injections minimum)

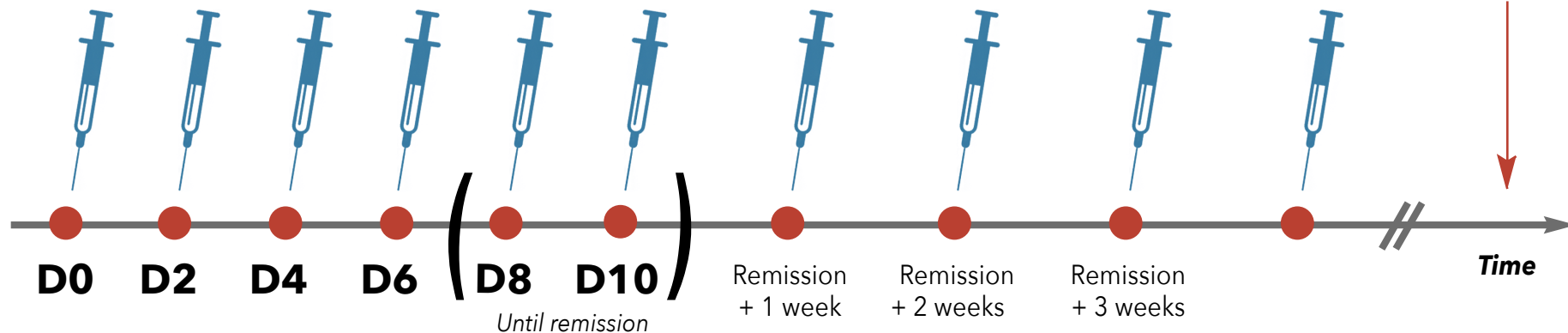
+
Prednisolone PO: 1mg/kg twice daily

MAINTENANCE STAGE (after remission*)

Feline Omega Interferon
1 MU/kg, SC once a week
+
Prednisolone PO sliding dose from 2mg/kg
twice daily to 0.5mg/kg e.o.d

Good recovery**
Expected
survival rate:
33.3% after
2-5 months
33.3% after
2 years
